



BURSARY AWARDS

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Irish Association of Cardiac Rehabilitation (IACR) awards two bursaries each year aimed at contributing to the continuous professional development of IACR members.
- The bursaries are awarded to meet the costs of attending a course and / or presenting at a conference related to cardiac rehabilitation.
- The bursary fund is €700.00 in total, awarded as follows:

€200: Educational course / conference directly related to Cardiac Rehabilitation **within Ireland.**

€500: Educational course / conference directly related to Cardiac Rehabilitation **outside Ireland**

Note: The IACR reserve the right to award bursaries of a greater or lesser value than that outlined above, and to award additional bursaries if appropriate.

- Closing date for applications is Friday June 25th 2010.
- Successful recipients will be announced at the IACR AGM in October.

APPLICATION CONDITIONS

- Applicants must be current members of the IACR.
- Only one application per person is accepted.
- Application forms must be completed personally and in full.
- Applications must be received before the closing date.
- Previous bursary recipients can re-apply.
- Successful recipients must submit a written summary of the course / conference attended for publication in the IACR newsletter.

SELECTION PROCESS

- Applications will be considered by the IACR council once the closing date has passed.
- IACR council members may apply for a bursary award but they must absent themselves from the selection process.
- Priority will be given to applicants who have been invited to present at a conference.

- Previous recipients can re-apply. However in the event of two applications of equal merit, priority will be given to the applicant who has not previously been supported by the IACR.
- In the event of a split decision the IACR President will select the successful recipient.
- The decision of the council is final.
